Since our inception in 1989, the SUNY CPD has been located in Syracuse, NY, as founding campuses saw Syracuse as an easy driving distance to participate in training and community meetings.

During the pandemic shut down, CPD meeting facilities went unused and our programs and services transitioned to an online format. With our lease ending and in an effort to be fiscally responsibile, we downsized our facilities in June of 2021 and began sharing space with SUNY Empire State College, located in the same building.

Program Coordinator, Jennifer Snyder, worked with the team on offering an event that resembled a traditional SUNY college fair. Delivered using OnAir, the SUNY CPD virtual conferece platform, students attended two live presentations *Which SUNY Are You?* and *Navigating the Financial Aid Process*.
