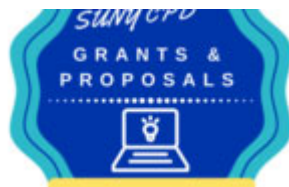

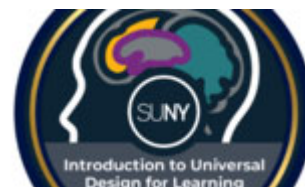

SUNY Partners with Deque University To Offer Accessibility Training

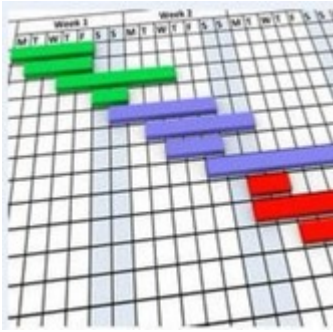
