TRANSITION TO A NEW EVENTS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Our event management system is central to everything we do at the CPD. Cvent offers all the core features of our previous system, including event websites, online registration, abstract and proposal submissions, SUNY Single SignOn (SSO), financial processing, and participant activity tracking. However, the move to Cvent enhanced our ability to address accessibility needs, create more dynamic program websites, and simplify administrative processes on the back end. Users have found the platform's interface intuitive and responsive.

PUBLIC GOOD U: STRENGTHENING THE CASE FOR PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION

CPD Provided Conference Support Services, planning management, and organization of Public Good U, organized by SUNY University Faculty Senate, SUNY Faculty Council of Community Colleges, and State University of New York in partnership with the City University of New York. Public Good U attracted over 300 people and highlighted the vital role of publicly funded colleges and universities in providing accessible education, fostering economic growth, and promoting community engagement. Each presentation and conversation underscored the importance of our mission in advancing equity, innovation, and economic development.

AS PROGRAM AREA SIGNATURE ACHIEVEMENT

 Technical Programs: Launch of the SUNY COA (Computer Officers Association) Mentoring Program — advancing IT Leadership — 14 Participants from 11 SUNY campuses.

- SAIL Leadership Programs: In response to campus requests, CPD launched a fully online version of the unique Department Chair Academy, offering SUNY's chair an opportunity to prepare for the critical role. The academy is now offered twice a year in either the winter or summer intersessions, giving participants preference as to modality: fully online asynchronous or a hybrid version.
- SUNY Online Program: Launched the newly redesigned Distance Learning Leaders and Instructional Design Certificate Programs.




